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Illinois State Police Conducts Joint Offender Registration Enforcement Detail in Peoria Area

PEORIA – The Illinois State Police (ISP), partnering with multiple law enforcement agencies, arrested numerous non-compliant convicted offenders and obtained dozens of charges as a result of a joint enforcement detail at more than 25 locations in the Peoria area to ensure compliance with the Illinois Sex Offender Registration Act and the Illinois Murderer and Violent Offenders Against Youth (MVOAY) Act.

On August 26, 2026, officers brought unregistered offenders into compliance and arrested multiple individuals on outstanding warrants for offenses including probation violations, Possession of a Controlled Substance, Aggravated Unlawful Possession of a Weapon by a Felon, and Driving While License Suspended. A stolen vehicle was also recovered.
