ORDER OF THE STATEWIDE 9-1-1 ADMINISTRATOR

WHEREAS, the CalComm Regional Joint ETSB submitted a modification plan with the Office of the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator on June 6, 2022, seeking to opt in the Village of Dixmoor;

WHEREAS the modification plan has been read and reviewed by the Department and the Administrator; and

WHEREAS the modification plan seeks to opt in the Village of Dixmoor into the CalComm Regional Joint 911 System;

WHEREAS as it relates to "wireless" surcharge monies, Section 30(b)(1)(D) and 30(2)(E) of the ETSA directs the Department to make monthly grants to the appropriate 9-1-1 Authority currently taking wireless 9-1-1 based upon zip code billing of wireless subscribers. Accordingly, the IGA specified the boundary change resulting from Dixmoor disengaging with Cook County and consolidating with CalComm and specified that CalComm will then be responsible to account for such monies in its audited annual financial reporting as required under Section 40 of the ETSA.

WHEREAS Cook County and CalComm have entered into an IGA concerning the payment of 9-1-1 surcharge, the financial reporting and auditing of the funds, and other specifics concerning the addition of Dixmoor to the CalComm Regional Joint 911 System.

On June 8, 2022, Stacy Ross, 911 Manager, Statewide 9-1-1 Bureau filed a Technical Review to the Application. The Technical Review met the requirements of 83 Illinois Administrative Code Part 1325.

NOW THEREFORE, the Administrator orders the following;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the CalComm Regional Joint ETSB's request for approval of its modification plan as follows:

Opting in the Village of Dixmoor from the Cook County 9-1-1 System to the CalComm Regional 9-1-1 System

pursuant to Title 83: Public Utilities Chapter IV: Department of State Police Part 1325 - Standards of Service Applicable to 9-1-1 Emergency Systems Section 205, is hereby approved subject to the requirements of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the CalComm modification will be completed no later than June 30, 2022.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that CalComm's 9-1-1 System Service Provider will conduct a P.01 Study and if necessary, a Traffic Study to determine the number of 9-1-1 trunks required to serve the CalComm 9-1-1 System with the addition of Dixmoor.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the CalComm 9-1-1 System will file with the Administrator a Wireless 9-1-1 Plan along with an updated Zip Code AGREEMENT that adds Dixmoor to their current Plan with an effective date no later than June 30, 2022.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Dixmoor surcharge payments currently being distributed to the Cook County 9-1-1 System shall begin to be distributed to the CalComm Regional 9-1-1 System as defined in 50 ILCS 750/30 beginning with the September 2022 remit period.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that CalComm is responsible for the accounting and audited annual financial reporting for Dixmoor wireless surcharge monies.

This Order is a final administrative decision of the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator subject to review under the Administrative Review Law, 735 ILCS 5/3-101. In the event you wish to seek review of or appeal this Order, you are advised:

- 1. Every action seeking review of such final decision shall be commenced by the filing of a Complaint and the issuance of Summons in the Circuit Court within 35 days from the date a copy of the decision was served upon the parties.
- 2. In your action seeking review you must name in the Complaint, and issue a Summons for, each party of record to the case other than yourself.
- 3. Attached below is a list of all parties of record to this case, including the name and address of the agency or officer entering the Order, and the addresses of each party where the parties may be served with pleadings, notices, or service of process for any review or further proceedings.
- 4. You are not required to file any motion or request for reconsideration with the Department or the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator before filing your action for review in the Circuit Court. The administrative rules of the Department do not require or allow for any further proceedings before the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator.
