ORDER OF THE STATEWIDE 9-1-1 ADMINISTRATOR

WHEREAS, the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System submitted a modification plan with the Office of the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator on April 18, 2024, seeking to opt out the Village of Crestwood and the Village of Worth;

WHEREAS the modification plan has been read and reviewed by the Department and the Administrator; and

WHEREAS the modification plan seeks to opt out the Village of Crestwood and the Village of Worth into the Cook County 9-1-1 System from the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System;

WHEREAS as it relates to "wireline" surcharge monies the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System and the Cook County ETSB have entered into an IGA allowing wireline surcharge monies to be paid to Cook County and requiring Cook County to account for such monies in its audited annual financial reporting as required under Section 40 of the ETSA.

WHEREAS as it relates to "wireless" surcharge monies, Section 30(b)(1)(D) and 30(2)(E) of the ETSA directs the Department to make monthly grants to the appropriate 9-1-1 Authority currently taking wireless 9-1-1 based upon zip code billing of wireless subscribers. Accordingly, the IGA specified the boundary change resulting from Crestwood and Worth disengaging with Southwest Central and consolidating with Cook County and specified that Cook County will then be responsible to account for such monies in its audited annual financial reporting as required under Section 40 of the ETSA.

NOW THEREFORE, the Administrator orders the following;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System's request for approval of its modification plan as follows:

Opting out the Village of Crestwood and the Village of Worth from the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System to the Cook County 9-1-1 System pursuant to Title 83: Public Utilities Chapter IV: Department of State Police Part 1325 - Standards of Service Applicable to 9-1-1 Emergency Systems Section 205, is hereby approved subject to the requirements of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System modification will be completed no later than May 31, 2024.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Crestwood and Worth wireline and wireless surcharge remittances currently being remitted to the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System shall begin to be distributed to the Cook County 9-1-1 System as defined in 50 ILCS 750/30 beginning with the September 2024 remit period.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Cook County is responsible for the accounting and audited annual financial reporting for Countryside's wireline and wireless surcharge monies.
