Application for 9-1-1 Modification Plan

# ORDER OF THE STATEWIDE 9-1-1 ADMINISTRATOR

**WHEREAS** the CenCom 9-1-1 System submitted a modification plan with the Office of the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator on February 24, 2022, seeking to opt out the Village of Barrington;

**WHEREAS** the modification plan has been read and reviewed by the Department and the Administrator; and

WHEREAS the modification plan seeks to opt out the Village of Barrington into the Northwest Central 9-1-1 System from the CenCom 9-1-1 System;

**WHEREAS** as it relates to "wireless" surcharge monies, Section 30(b)(1)(D) and 30(2)(E) of the ETSA directs the Department to make monthly grants to the appropriate 9-1-1 Authority currently taking wireless 9-1-1 based upon zip code billing of wireless subscribers. Accordingly, the IGA specified the boundary change resulting from Barrington disengaging with the CenCom 9-1-1 System and consolidating with the Northwest Central 9-1-1 System and specified that the Northwest Central 9-1-1 System will then be responsible to account for such monies in its audited annual financial reporting as required under Section 40 of the ETSA.

NOW THEREFORE, the Administrator orders the following;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the CenCom 9-1-1 System request for approval of its modification plan as follows:

Opting out the Village of Barrington from the CenCom 9-1-1 System to the Northwest Central 9-1-1 System.

pursuant to Title 83: Public Utilities Chapter IV: Department of State Police Part 1325 - Standards of Service Applicable to 9-1-1 Emergency Systems Section 205, is hereby approved subject to the requirements of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Northwest Central 9-1-1 System modification will be completed no later than May 1, 2022.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that CenCom 9-1-1's 9-1-1 Service Provider will conduct a P.01 Study and if necessary, a Traffic Study to determine the number of 9-1-1 trunks required to serve the CenCom 9-1-1 System with the departure of Barrington.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Barrington wireless surcharge payments currently being distributed to the CenCom 9-1-1 System shall begin to be distributed to the Northwest Central 9-1-1 System as defined in 50 ILCS 750/30 beginning with the distribution of the May 2022 surcharge funds.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Northwest Central 9-1-1 System is responsible for the accounting and audited annual financial reporting for Barrington wireless surcharge monies.

This Order is a final administrative decision of the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator subject to review under the Administrative Review Law, 735 ILCS 5/3-101. In the event you wish to seek review of or appeal this Order, you are advised:

- 1. Every action seeking review of such final decision shall be commenced by the filing of a Complaint and the issuance of Summons in the Circuit Court within 35 days from the date a copy of the decision was served upon the parties.
- 2. In your action seeking review you must name in the Complaint, and issue a Summons for, each party of record to the case other than yourself.
- 3. Attached below is a list of all parties of record to this case, including the name and address of the agency or officer entering the Order, and the addresses of each party where the parties may be served with pleadings, notices, or service of process for any review or further proceedings.
- 4. You are not required to file any motion or request for reconsideration with the Department or the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator before filing your action for review in the Circuit Court. The administrative rules of the Department do not require or allow for any further proceedings before the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator.
