Modification Plan

ORDER OF THE STATEWIDE 9-1-1 ADMINISTRATOR

WHEREAS the Cook County ETSB submitted a modification plan with the Office of the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator on September 23, 2021, seeking to opt in the City of Chicago Heights;

WHEREAS the modification plan has been read and reviewed by the Department and the Administrator; and

WHEREAS the modification plan seeks to opt in the City of Chicago Heights into the Cook County 9-1-1 System;

WHEREAS as it relates to "wireline" surcharge monies the City of Chicago Heights and the Cook County ETSB have entered into an IGA allowing wireline surcharge monies to be paid to Cook County and requiring Cook County to account for such monies in its audited annual financial reporting as required under Section 40 of the ETSA.

WHEREAS as it relates to "wireless" surcharge monies, Section 30(b)(1)(D) and 30(2)(E) of the ETSA directs the Department to make monthly grants to the appropriate 9-1-1 Authority currently taking wireless 9-1-1 based upon zip code billing of wireless subscribers. Accordingly, the IGA specified the boundary change resulting from Chicago Heights consolidating with Cook County and specified that Cook County will then be responsible to account for such monies in its audited annual financial reporting as required under Section 40 of the ETSA.

WHEREAS Cook County and the City of Chicago Heights have entered into an IGA concerning the payment of 9-1-1 surcharge, the financial reporting and auditing of the funds, and other specifics concerning the addition of the City of Chicago Heights to the Cook County 9-1-1 System.

NOW THEREFORE, the Administrator orders the following;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Cook County ETSB's request for approval of its modification plan as follows:

Opting in the City of Chicago Heights to the Cook County 9-1-1 System pursuant to Title 83: Public Utilities Chapter IV: Department of State Police Part 1325 - Standards of Service Applicable to 9-1-1 Emergency Systems Section 205, is hereby approved subject to the requirements of this Order.

later than November 30, 2021.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Cook County's 9-1-1 System Service Provider will conduct a P.01 Study and if necessary, a Traffic Study to determine the number of 9-1-1 trunks required to serve the Cook County 9-1-1 System with the addition of Chicago Heights.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Cook County 9-1-1 System will file with the Administrator a Wireless 9-1-1 Plan for all Carriers that adds Chicago Heights to their current Plan with an effective date no later than November 30, 2021.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Chicago Heights surcharge payments currently being distributed to the Chicago Heights ETSB shall begin to be distributed to the Cook County 9-1-1 System as defined in 50 ILCS 750/30 beginning with the December 2021 distribution of surcharge funds.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Chicago Heights ETSB will transfer any reserve fund balance to the Cook County ETSB by December 31, 2021.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Chicago Heights will submit a 2021 AFR Report by January 31, 2021, that will include the reporting of surcharge and other revenue received, and expenditures made from January 1, 2021, through December 31, 2021.


