ORDER OF THE STATEWIDE 9-1-1 ADMINISTRATOR

WHEREAS, the Vernon Hills 9-1-1 System submitted a modification plan with the Office of the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator on June 16, 2025, seeking to opt out the Village of Libertyville;

WHEREAS the modification plan has been read and reviewed by the Statewide 9-1-1 Bureau and the Administrator; and

WHEREAS the modification plan seeks to opt out the Village of Libertyville into the Glenview 9-1-1 System from the Vernon Hills 9-1-1 System;

WHEREAS as it relates to “wireline” surcharge monies the Vernon Hills 9-1-1 System and the Glenview JETSB have entered into an IGA allowing wireline surcharge monies to be paid to Glenview and requiring Glenview to account for such monies in its audited annual financial reporting as required under Section 40 of the ETSA.

WHEREAS as it relates to “wireless” surcharge monies, Section 30(b)(1)(D) and 30(2)(E) of the ETSA directs the Statewide 9-1-1 Bureau to make monthly grants to the appropriate 9-1-1 Authority currently taking wireless 9-1-1 based upon zip code billing of wireless subscribers. Accordingly, the IGA specified the boundary change resulting from Libertyville disengaging with the Vernon Hills 9-1-1 System and consolidating with Glenview and specified that Glenview will then be responsible to account for such monies in its audited annual financial reporting as required under Section 40 of the ETSA.

On June 17, 2025, Catherine Tanner, 911 Analyst, Statewide 9-1-1 Bureau filed a Technical Review of the Application which included the Illinois Commerce Commission’s review. The Technical Review met the requirements of 83 Illinois Administrative Code Part 1325.

NOW THEREFORE, the Administrator orders the following;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Vernon Hills 9-1-1 System’s request for approval of its modification plan is as follows:

Opting out the Village of Libertyville from the Vernon Hills 9-1-1 System to the Glenview 9-1-1 System pursuant to Title 83: Public Utilities Chapter IV: Illinois State Police Part 1325 - Standards of Service Applicable to 9-1-1 Emergency Systems Section 205, is hereby approved subject to the requirements of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Vernon Hills 9-1-1 System modification will be completed no later than June 30, 2025.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Libertyville wireline and wireless surcharge remittances currently being remitted to the Vernon Hills 9-1-1 System shall begin to be distributed to Glenview 9-1-1 System as defined in 50 ILCS 750/30 beginning with the October 2025 remit period.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Glenview is responsible for the accounting and audited annual financial reporting for Libertyville's wireline and wireless surcharge monies.
