## SECTION IV -SUPPLEMENTAL DATA

## DOMESTIC CRIMES, CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN, CRIMES AGAINST SCHOOL PERSONNEL, HATE CRIMES DATA

In April 1996, the Illinois State Police began collecting additional crime information. This data includes statistics pertaining to offenses mandated by state statutes and offenses concerning children. The data in this section reflects crimes occurring from January 1 through December 31, 2004. Due to limitations of agencies' reporting systems, all agencies are not included in the totals presented in the following tables. In some cases, the percentages may not sum to 100 due to rounding.

### **Domestic Crimes**

This category reflects domestic-related crimes. Reporting domestic violence is mandated by Chapter 20 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, 2630/5.1. Domestic-related crimes are defined as crimes committed by family or household members, including spouses, former spouses, parents, children, stepchildren and other persons related by blood or marriage, persons who share or formerly shared a common dwelling, and persons who have or allegedly have a child in common. In the case of a high-risk adult with disabilities, family or household member includes any person who has the responsibility for a high-risk adult as a result of a family relationship or who has assumed responsibility for all or a portion of the care of a high-risk adult with disabilities voluntarily, or by express or implied contract, or court order.

### **Crimes Against Children**

Although reporting in this category is not mandated by state statutes, information is collected to research and evaluate the problems of offenses against children. Contributing agencies are not required to report this data to the I-UCR Program. All crimes reported to participating agencies that involve victims aged 16 years and younger are included in this category.

#### **Crimes Against School Personnel**

The reporting of attacks on school personnel is mandated by Chapter 105 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, 5/10-21.7. The I-UCR Program collects information relating to all crimes committed against teachers, administrative personnel, or educational support personnel. These persons can include teacher's aides, bus drivers, or janitors, etc., who are employed by the school.

#### **Hate Crime**

The reporting of hate crime information is mandated by Chapter 20 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, 2605-390(a). A hate crime is committed when, by reason of the actual or perceived race, color, creed, religion, ancestry, gender, sexual orientation, physical or mental disability, or national origin of another individual or group of individuals, a person commits assault, battery, aggravated assault, misdemeanor theft, criminal trespass to residence, misdemeanor criminal damage to property, criminal trespass to vehicle, criminal trespass to real property, mob action, or disorderly conduct.




### Relationship Type\* 2004









## 2004/2003 Comparison by Day of Week








