SECTION IV -SUPPLEMENTAL DATA

DOMESTIC CRIMES, CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN, CRIMES AGAINST SCHOOL PERSONNEL, HATE CRIMES DATA

In April 1996, the Illinois State Police began collecting statistics pertaining to offenses mandated by state and federal statutes and offenses concerning children. Data in this section reflects crimes occurring from January 1 through December 31, 2009. Training efforts throughout 2009 increased agency participation and may have contributed to increases in the number of offenses reported as compared to the previous year. Despite increased participation due to training, there remain agencies incapable of reporting supplemental data due to the limitations of their reporting systems.

Domestic Crimes

The reporting of domestic-related offenses is mandated by Chapter 20 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, 2630/5.1. Domestic-related offenses is defined as any crime committed where a domestic relationship exists between the victim and offender. Domestic relationship is defined as family or household members, including spouses, former spouses, parents, children, stepchildren and other persons related by blood or by present or previous marriage, persons who share or formerly share a common dwelling, persons who have or allegedly have a child in common, persons who have or have had a dating or engagement relationship, and persons with disabilities and their personal care assistants or care givers outside the context of an employee of a public or private care facility.

Crimes Against Children

Although reporting in this category is not mandated by state statutes, information is voluntarily submitted by agencies providing statistics used in researching the type and frequency of offenses committed against victims aged 16 years and younger.

Crimes Against School Personnel

The reporting of attacks on school personnel is mandated by Chapter 105 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, 5/10-21.7. Aggravated batteries and aggravated assaults committed against teachers, administrative personnel, or other school personnel are reported. Other school personnel includes teacher's aides, bus drivers, hall monitors, custodians, cafeteria workers, etc., who are employed by the school.

Hate Crime

The reporting of hate crime information is mandated by Chapter 20 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, 2605-390(a) and the Federal Hate Crime Act. A hate crime is committed when, by reason of the actual or perceived race, color, creed, religion, ancestry, gender, sexual orientation, physical or mental disability, or national origin of another individual or group of individuals, a person commits homicide, criminal sexual assault, robbery, aggravated battery/assault, battery, assault, burglary, theft, motor vehicle theft, arson, criminal trespass, criminal damage to property, mob action, disorderly conduct, or harassment. During 2009, 141 hate crime incidents were reported. Some incidents involved multiple offenses, accounting for a total of 155 offenses committed.








