CRIME TRENDS

Violent Crimes/Property Crimes

Please note the following while reviewing this section:

The Downstate Offense Total is the sum of data reported by sheriffs' offices, police departments (other than the Chicago Police Department), colleges, universities and the Secretary of State's Office.

The Chicago Police Department Total is the data reported only by the Chicago Police Department.

The State Offense Total is the sum of the Chicago Police Department and Downstate Illinois.

Each category of offense information reflects data for offenses that occurred between January 1, 1997, and December 31, 1997. Due to late or adjusted data, 1996 figures reflected in this publication are not comparable with those figures published in Crime in Illinois 1996.

The 1996 and 1997 crime rates for this section were calculated using the 1996 estimated population statistics or figures obtained from a special census. The statistics indicated in this section are the most recent complete population census figures available for each year. Section II, Crime Index Offense/Crime Rate, contains a more detailed explanation.
