# DOMESTIC CRIMES CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN CRIMES AGAINST SCHOOL PERSONNEL HATE CRIMES DATA

In April 1996, the Illinois State Police began the collection of additional crime information. This data includes statistics pertaining to offenses mandated by state statute and offenses concerning children. The following data in this section reflects crimes having occurred from January 1, 1998 through December 31, 1998. Due to limitations on agencies' reporting systems, all agencies are not included in the totals presented in the following charts.

#### **Domestic Crimes**

The following data in this category reflects crimes which are domestic related. Reporting of domestic violence is mandated by Chapter 20, Illinois Compiled Statutes 2630/5.1. Domestic related is defined as family or household members which include spouses, former spouses, parents, children, stepchildren and other persons related by blood or marriage, persons who share or formerly shared a common dwelling and persons who have or allegedly have a child in common. In the case of a high-risk adult with disabilities, family or household member includes any person who has the responsibility for a high-risk adult as a result of a family relationship or who has assumed responsibility for all or a portion of the care of a high-risk adult with disabilities voluntarily, or by express or implied contract, or court order.

#### **Crimes Against Children**

Although reporting in this category is not mandated by state statutes, information is collected to research and evaluate the problems of offenses against children. Contributing agencies are not required to report this data to the Uniform Crime Reporting Program. This information is optional and is submitted voluntarily by the reporting agencies. All crimes committed against children 16 years and younger are included in this category.

#### **Crimes Against School Personnel**

The reporting of attacks against school personnel is mandated by Chapter 105, Illinois Compiled Statutes 5/10-21.7. The Uniform Crime Reporting Program collects information relating to all crimes committed against teachers, teacher personnel, administrative personnel or educational support personnel. These persons can include teachers' aides, bus drivers or janitors etc. who are employed by the school.

#### **Hate Crimes**

The reporting of hate crime information is mandated by Chapter 20, Illinois Compiled Statutes 2605/55a. A person commits hate crime when, by reason of the actual or perceived race, color, creed, religion, ancestry, gender, sexual orientation, physical or mental disability, or national origin of another individual or group of individuals, he commits assault, battery, aggravated assault, misdemeanor theft, criminal trespass to residence, misdemeanor criminal damage to property, criminal trespass to vehicle, criminal trespass to real property, mob action or disorderly conduct.





1998 Offense Type







## Crimes Against School Personnel State Totals by Day of Week Comparison






