DELETION OF I-UCR PROGRAM DATA

The records retention schedule for the Illinois Uniform Crime Reporting (I-UCR) Program's data submitted by Illinois law enforcement agencies has been modified. Data retention is now limited to current year plus four years. In order to comply with the schedule, data that has been entered in to and is stored in the reporting tool for the years of 2010 through 2014 will deleted on August 1, 2019. Data bases housing records before the reporting tool was deployed have already been deleted. Beginning in January 2021, the process of deleting the oldest year of data annually will occur.

Agencies are encouraged to review the data listed below scheduled for deletion and download data an agency <u>chooses</u> to retain in-house prior to August 1, 2019. Once deleted, the data will not be retrievable by the agency or the I-UCR Program.

2014 DATA

Index Crime, Domestic Offenses, Hate Crime, and School Incidents data for the 2014 reporting year are accessed by selecting the associated tab located to the right of the 2010-2013 REPORTING tab.

Once a reporting element tab is selected, the home page will display. In the informational box located in the lower left hand corner of the home page is a REPORTS button. Select the REPORTS button for guidelines on how to access and download reports.

2010 THROUGH 2013 DATA

Index Crime, Supplemental Data (attacks against school personnel, domestic offenses and crimes against children), and Hate Crime data prior to the 2014 reporting year are accessed by first selecting the 2010-2013 REPORTING tab in the reporting tool. The page displayed allows the user to select any one of these three reporting elements. Once a reporting element button is selected, the associated home page will display. From the home page, select the GO TO REPORTS button.

Index Crime: GO TO INDEX REPORTS FOR 2010-2013

Hate Crime: GO TO HATE CRIME REPORTS FOR 2012-2013

NOTE: The ability to enter hate crime data in to the reporting tool was not available until 2012. Data prior to 2012 has been deleted and reports are not available.

Supplemental Reporting: GO TO SUPPLEMENTAL REPORTS

NOTE: The ability to enter supplemental data in to the reporting tool was not available until 2012. Data prior to 2012 has been deleted and reports are not available.

The instructions on how to access and download reports is the same as the processes for 2014 data.

CRIME IN ILLINOIS PUBLICATIONS

Crime in Illinois publications for 1997 through 2017 are available at the bottom of the I-UCR Program webpage. The publication provides index crime <u>offense and school incident annual totals</u> for each agency; however, only state-wide data is available for Hate Crime, Supplemental Homicide Reporting, Arrest Related Deaths, and Officer Non-Fatal Shootings.
