

DIVISION OF INTERNAL INVESTIGATION

2023 ANNUAL STATISTICAL REPORT

In 2023, the Division of Internal Investigation (DII) opened 141 cases of Illinois State Police employee misconduct. In 53 investigations completed by DII, 5 employees received discipline and of those 1 resigned prior to discipline being served, 4 were exonerated, 11 were not sustained, 1 was unfounded, 3 were administratively closed, and 28 cases are still open. Cases of less serious transgressions (88) were referred to the employee's division to investigate.

In 2023, DII opened 79 cases of employee misconduct reported by other agencies under the purview of the Governor. Of those cases investigated by DII, 2 were administratively closed, 13 were declined by the prosecutor, 1 was a conviction, 2 were dismissed, 21 were not sustained, and 1 was unfounded. There are 39 cases still open.

In 2023, 1036 background investigations were completed for ISP applicants and for criminal justice agencies under the Governor's purview.
