

**DIVISION OF INTERNAL INVESTIGATION**  
**2024 ANNUAL STATISTICAL REPORT**

In 2024, the Division of Internal Investigation (DII) opened 170 cases of Illinois State Police employee misconduct. In 69 investigations completed by DII, 10 employees received discipline and 1 resigned prior to discipline being served, 1 was terminated, 17 were exonerated, 4 were not sustained, 1 was unfounded, and 35 cases are still open. Cases of less serious transgressions (101) were referred to the employee's division to investigate.

In 2024, DII opened 96 cases of employee misconduct reported by other agencies under the purview of the Governor. Of those cases investigated by DII, 2 were administratively closed, 11 were declined by the prosecutor, 3 were dismissed, and 25 were not sustained. There are 55 cases still open.

In 2024, 1344 background investigations were completed for ISP applicants and for criminal justice agencies under the Governor's purview.
