

DIVISION OF INTERNAL INVESTIGATION

2025 ANNUAL STATISTICAL REPORT

In 2025, the Division of Internal Investigation (DII) opened 164 cases of Illinois State Police employee misconduct. In 73 investigations completed by DII, 9 employees received discipline and 3 resigned prior to discipline being served, 2 were administratively closed, 3 were exonerated, 7 were not sustained, and 49 cases are still open. Cases of less serious transgressions (91) were referred to the employee's division to investigate.

In 2025, DII opened 113 cases of employee misconduct reported by other agencies under the purview of the Governor. Of those cases investigated by DII, 1 was administratively closed, 21 were declined by the prosecutor, 3 led to a conviction, 2 were dismissed, 2 were unfounded, and 22 were not sustained. There are 62 cases still open.

In 2025, 919 background investigations were completed for ISP applicants and for criminal justice agencies under the Governor's purview.
